## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

Henceforth, the Director of the Washoe County Department of Juvenile Services shall, in the event of an emergency requiring the evacuation of detainees housed at a juvenile detention facility located within Washoe County, namely the McGee Center, located at 2097 Longley Lane, Reno, Nevada 89502, or the Jan Evans Center, located at 650 Ferrari McLeod, Reno, Nevada, 89512, have the authority and discretion to assess each individual placement and either temporarily release the detainee to the custody of his or her parent(s) or guardian(s) or to place the detainee in another detention facility within the region until such time as it is safe to return to the facility, without further order of this Court.
