17 ORDER APPOINTING PHYSICIAN TO CONDUCT EXAMINATION OF PERSONS ALLEGED TO
18 BE MENTALLY ILL

19 NRS 433A.240 requires the Court to "promptly cause two or more physicians or licensed
20 psychologists, one of whom must always be a physician, to examine the person alleged to be mentally ill
21 or request an evaluation by an evaluation team from the division of the person alleged to be mentally ill"
22 after the filing of a petition to commence proceedings for the involuntary court-ordered admission of such
23 a person. The Court has been informed that Dr. Kenneth Clark, M.D. is no longer able to perform the
24 evaluations required by NRS 433A.240. Wherefore, the Court hereby extends the appointment Dr.
25 Melissa Piasecki and Dr. Ole Thienhaus to conduct the examinations required by NRS 433A.240 on an
emergency basis until a permanent replacement is determined.



1 Dr. Piasecki and Dr. Thienhaus shall be compensated at a reasonable rate for such examinations, not to
2 exceed \$950.00 per week. The \$950.00 amount includes the examination/evaluation, preparation of
3 written findings/evaluation, and testimony at the commitment hearing.
