

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 08-06

Whereas the Second Judicial District Court Rules authorize the Chief Judge to
make changes to the Probate calendar and manage the Probate Department; and

the Probate Commissioner some discretion in setting hearings will more effectively
address the increased caseload in Probate, and

HEREBY ORDERED:

21

1. The Probate Commissioner's calendar will commence at 8:30 a.m. on dates to
be determined by the Probate Department, and that the calendar will be heard
in the Probate Department of the Second Judicial Court, 75 Court Street, Reno,
Nevada, in accordance with Second Judicial District Court Rule 57.2.

2. That the Probate Commissioner will set and conduct or cause to be conducted
a settlement conference in all contested probate matters.

- 3. All contested Probate matters that have not settled with the Probate Commissioner or otherwise, shall be heard by the assigned Probate Judge or Alternate Probate Judge within 90 days of an objection being made.
- 4. Upon recommendation of the Probate Judge and Commissioner, Contested Probate matters shall be set on a "stacked trial calendar" on Mondays and because of the trailing nature of a "stacked trial calendar", all parties must be prepared for the matter to be heard any day of the week of the Monday setting.
- 5. The Chief Judge will handle overflow of the contested matters in the same manner as all other overflow of General Jurisdiction Division cases.
- 6. This Administrative Order shall be in effect until December 31, 2009, or until specifically modified or rescinded by subsequent Administrative Order.
