ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2016-03

WHEREAS, the Second Judicial District Court currently operates ten Specialty Courts, which are:

- Adult Drug Court;
- Diversion Court;
- Prison Reentry Court;
- Veteran's Court;
- Family Drug Court;
- Family Mental Health Court;
- Youth Offender Court;
- Medication Assisted Treatment Court;
- Felony Driving Under the Influence Court; and
- Mental Health Court – Including Regional Mental Health Court.

WHEREAS, Judge Peter Breen, Judge Archie Blake, and Judge Deborah Schumacher, preside over Adult Drug Court, Diversion Court, Prison Reentry Court, Felony DUI Court, and Mental Health Court on a rotating basis;

1 WHEREAS, Judge Walker requested that he no longer preside over the Family
2 Drug Court and Family Mental Health Court due to conflicting obligations;

3 WHEREAS, the Family Bench voted that Judge Cynthia Lu will replace Judge
4 Walker as the presiding judge over the Family Drug Court and Family Mental Health
5 Court;

6 WHEREAS, Judge Lidia Stiglich presides over the Youth Offender Court;

7 WHEREAS, Judge Scott Freeman has indicated an interest in presiding over
8 the Youth Offender Court when Judge Stiglich is unavailable;

9 WHEREAS, the Second Judicial District Court bench voted that Judge David
10 Hardy, who has indicated an interest in presiding over the Veteran's Court, be
11 appointed therein;

12 WHEREAS, the Chief Judge of the Second Judicial District Court may adopt
13 rules or regulations as are necessary for the orderly conduct of court business.

14 (WDCR 2(2), NRS 3.025(2)(c)).

15 NOW THEREFORE:

16 Judge Peter Breen, Judge Archie Blake, and Judge Deborah Schumacher, shall
17 continue to preside over these Specialty Courts on a rotating basis.

18 Judge Cynthia Lu shall preside over the Family Drug Court and Family
19 Mental Health Court;

20 Judge Stiglich shall continue to preside over the Youth Offender Court;

21 Judge Freeman shall preside over the Youth Offender Court when Judge
22 Stiglich is unavailable; and

23 Judge David Hardy shall preside over Veteran's Court;

24 This Administrative Order is effective immediately, except that Judge Lu shall
25 preside over Family Drug and Family Mental Health Court, beginning March 9, 2016.
