19 WHEREAS the Second Judicial District Court (“the District Court”) Chief Judge has  
20 authority to make administrative decisions pertaining to the business of the court (WDCR 2(2), NRS  
21 3.025(2)(c)) and incorporates all recitals set forth in Administrative Order (“AO”) 2020-02(E) as if  
22 set forth in full here; and,

25 TF will issue approximately eight (8) weeks before the scheduled TF identifying the trials set in the


