15 WHEREAS, pursuant to NRS 62B.020, the Court shall appoint an Alternative Special
16 Master in the Juvenile Division of the Second Judicial District Court concerning traffic
17 offenders; and

19 WHEREAS, Elizabeth Florez, Interim Director of Juvenile Services, has been
20 recommended to serve as an Alternative Special Master in the Juvenile Division of this Court;

22 WHEREAS, Christine Eckles, Division Director for Juvenile Services, has been
23 recommended to serve as an Alternative Special Master in the Juvenile Division of this Court;

1 WHEREAS, Juvenile Services Probation Managers Mathew Banovich, Taryn Bjelke,
2 Lance Mezger, and Joseph Saiz, have been recommended to serve as Alternative Special Masters
3 in the Juvenile Division of this Court; and

4 WHEREAS, Troy Harper, Detention Manager for Juvenile Services, has been
5 recommended to serve as an Alternative Special Master in the Juvenile Division of this Court;

8 WHEREAS, NRS 62B.020(3) requires any person appointed to act as a master of the
9 juvenile court to attend a course at the National Council of Juvenile and Family Court Judges in
10 Reno, Nevada, for the training of new judges of the juvenile court on the first occasion such a
11 course is offered after appointment; and

12 WHEREAS, NRS 62B.020(4) allows the Juvenile Court or the Chief Judge to appoint
13 another qualified person to act temporarily as a master of the juvenile court during a period
14 where the master who is regularly appointed is unable to act; and

16 WHEREAS, Frank Cervantes, Rodney Chapin and Rebecca Huddleston have all
17 previously served as Alternative Special Masters pursuant to NRS 62B.020, and are qualified to
18 act temporarily as an Alternative Special Master.

20 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:


- 21 1. Juvenile Services employees Elizabeth Florez, Christine Eckles, Mathew Banovich,
22 Taryn Bjelke, Lance Mezger, Joseph Saiz, and Troy Harper are hereby appointed as
23 Alternative Special Masters of Juvenile Traffic Offenders in the Juvenile Division of the
24 Court; and


2. If the education requirement contained at NRS 62B.020(3) has not already been met, each of the Alternative Special Masters appointed herein are ordered to attend training for new judges of the juvenile court at the next offering by the National Council of Juvenile and Family Court Judges; and
3. Should the Alternative Special Masters appointed under this Order be unable to act in this capacity, Frank Cervantes, Rodney Chapin and Rebecca Huddleston are hereby appointed to serve temporarily in this capacity.
4. This order supersedes all prior administrative orders on this point and shall remain in effect until modified by a subsequent order.
