ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2021-11

[AUDIOVISUAL AND IN PERSON HEARING SCHEDULE FOR CRIMINAL DOCKETS]

WHEREAS the Second Judicial District Court ("SJDC") Chief Judge has authority to make administrative decisions pertaining to the business of the court (WDCR 2(2), NRS 3.025(2)(c));

WHEREAS on March 12, 2020, Governor Steve Sisolak issued a Declaration of Emergency in Nevada in response to the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) pandemic ("Declaration of Emergency");

WHEREAS the Declaration of Emergency has not been rescinded although Directives have been issued regarding reopening;

WHEREAS the Declaration of Emergency and all Directives issued are available at: [gov.nv.gov/News/Emergency_Orders/Emergency Orders](http://gov.nv.gov/News/Emergency_Orders/Emergency_Orders) (last visited 6/29/2021);

1 WHEREAS on May 19, 2020, the Chief Judge entered Administrative Order (“AO”) 2020-
2 02(B) regarding general jurisdiction audiovisual hearing dockets for out of custody defendant cases;

3 WHEREAS on June 11 2020, the Chief Judge entered AO 2020-02(C) regarding general
4 jurisdiction audiovisual hearing dockets for in-custody and out of custody defendant cases;

5 WHEREAS on June 30, 2021, the Chief Judge entered AO 2021-05(B) regarding the
6 continued opening of the Second Judicial District Court (“SJDC”); and,

7 WHEREAS additional AOs have been issued on court matters. All AOs are available at
8 washocourts.com/Main/AdminOrders (last visited 6/29/2021).

9 **Accordingly, after review, and good cause appearing therefor, this Administrative**
10 **Order 2021-11 follows:**

11 This Order is intended to be consistent with the Declaration of Emergency and issued
12 Directives resulting from the Declaration of Emergency and subsequent renewals or extensions of
13 said Directives.

14 This Order is also intended to be consistent with AO 2021-05(B).
